COMPLIANCE

S.1492: Broadband Data Improvement Act – Requires schools with Internet access to educate minors about appropriate online behavior.

FCC Ruling: By July 2012, school districts applying for E-Rate funds must certify that their Internet safety policies provide for the education of students regarding appropriate online behavior and cyberbullying awareness and response.
