Considering an endorsement? You must -

- have a clear renewable teaching certificate
- have successful teaching experience prior to taking program
- have approval from principal and curriculum director (or designee)
- complete online registration for the first course
- submit an endorsement application prior to first class
- have a commitment to rigorous work
- have satisfactory computer skills
- complete field work and other outside assignments
- complete endorsement within two years to earn credit
- take courses in sequential order
