2009 RESA Goals**

#	Goal
1	Provide information, support forums, job-alike groups, and training events for administrators and support staffs.
2	Deliver training in best instructional practices and in implementation of the Georgia Performance Standards to member systems and to Alpine program teachers.
3	Deliver and document service volume to individual member systems which is proportionate and appropriate to system size and need.
4	Participate in the design, delivery, and/or evaluation of 20 or more system-specific programs/projects.
5	Increase the percentage of Alpine Program students meeting or exceeding standard on CRCT in each academic area as compared to the previous year.
6	Document high quality and participation rates of the 2009 Pioneer RESA Summer Leadership Conference.
7	Demonstrate communication with and service to area post-secondary institutions and to the Regional Library System.
9	Deliver at least one major data service to every Pioneer RESA system, to all schools with NI status, and to all schools not making AYP the most recent year.
10	Secure at least \$300,000 in external grant funding for member systems and/or for Pioneer RESA.
11	Develop and implement a RESA orientation process for new administrators.
12	Develop and implement strategies for increased support and training of school leaders and aspiring leaders.
13	Develop a long-range plan for providing additional instructional support for science instruction.
14	Develop a long-range plan for providing additional instructional support for social studies instruction.
15	Develop a plan for and begin implementation of on-line video-based professional learning.
16	Deliver presentations of effective practices which increase graduation rates to area educators and to the Pioneer RESA Board of Control.
17	Increase the composite graduation rate of all high schools in the Pioneer RESA region from 75.1% in 2008 toward a goal of 80%.
18	Develop a plan to restructure and improve the cost effectiveness of the Alpine Program.
19	Develop a plan for and implement site visits to system offices and schools and for periodic conferences with superintendents, central office administrators, and principals regarding services and local needs.
20	Develop media which details and promotes RESA services to systems and schools.
