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GEORGIA ALTERNATIVE LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

The inaugural cohort for the Pioneer RESA Georgia Alternative Leadership Certification Program will begin August 2020. The Tier I program is a twelve-month certification program that supports candidates in entry-level leadership positions below the principal and system level positions that do not supervise principals.

Admissions Criteria: Additional Criteria Apply for Non– Educators

- ◆ Employment in a position requiring leadership certification for one-half or more each day (system must apply for NL certificate for candidate)
- ◆ System recommendation for program admission
- ◆ Hold, at a minimum, a master's degree from a regionally-accredited college or university in a GaPSC certification field
- ◆ Provide evidence of successful teacher leadership experience
- ◆ Provide evidence of successful teaching
- ◆ Provide evidence of completion of GACE Ethics Assessment for Leadership (Entry 370)
- ◆ Exhibit professional leadership dispositions
- ◆ Provide evidence of experience engaging colleagues in professional learning opportunities
- ◆ Preferred: Hold Teacher Leadership or Coaching Endorsement

Candidates must successfully complete the Essentials Course (\$350 member/\$500 non-member) or the Pioneers in Leadership Program prior to entry into the Residency Program. The program consists of f2f and online modules.
